Vote on approval of 3/19/2019 meeting minutes. Passed unanimously.

Rather than a competition at the meetings, which had few entries of late it was suggested to have a "Show and Tell" instead, showing works in progress or finished. Voted on and passed unanimously.

It was decided that there will not be any door prizes at the meeting. Instead each Show and Tell person will get a raffle ticket. Only one prize will be given out and will be for a larger amount or other prize. Voted on and passed unanimously.

For the DVD's it was suggested that only a listing of DVD's with description be put on web site rather then cover pictures.

The exhibitors would receive a couple of tickets in their packet to present to the Lions Club to receive coffee and doughnuts.

Passed. No no votes

Show. Once the band starts playing, the period is 45 minutes, we cannot call raffle ticket numbers due to the band noise. Suggestion was for the band to play for 30 minutes rather than the 45 minutes. The calling of ticket numbers should be coordinated with band. Need more prizes.

Tickets are used to see number for paid attendance. Need another ticket color for vets and kids so that they are also part of the drawing for prizes.

People's Choice. Need a good way of keeping folks away from the carvings so they do not accidently damage a carving. Last show the carvings were not away from folks looking at them until a table was pushed up so that they were away from the carvings.

Pat Murphy and Fred Azelio, next show will be their last. They have 3 ring binders that can be followed for the new people that take this project over. Info in the binders are things like previous winners, applications, etc.

Should have a club table setup at show so folks can get info and become new members.

Web site maintenance fee. The WEB admin needs to be compensated for making updates on an ongoing basis. A proposal of \$20/month for the 10 months the club is active, was presented by John Sabina. Passed. No no votes.

Minutes should be proof read and approved prior to being posted in the newsletter. Was pointed out that this is really a legal document therefore needs to be accurate. In the future the previous meeting minutes will be brought to meeting and approved. Then go to newsletter. This makes the minutes one month late. Need new form for joining club.

Club dues next year will be \$15 for those that get the newsletter via email and \$20 for those that want/require newsletter to be mailed.

Reason for the \$20 fee if newsletter is mailed is how expensive it is becoming to mail. Postage is going higher and printing is also going higher.

There were 77 paid tables at our show this year.

Possibly have a demo area for carving so folks can get some idea what wood carving is about.
