## February Meeting Minutes

Postage for newsletter is \$.55 plus cost of printing. Everyone that can, please get this via your email and let someone like John Sabina know. If you go to the Metrocarvers web site, then go to newsletter at the bottom where there is an option at the bottom to notify email only.

It was decided to discontinue the storage locker and either get rid of or handle things like the Go-Byes in a different way.

Since there were steel cabinets in the storage locker that Steve Brandon had purchased, it was decided that Steve would get these to store things in at his house for now.

Library books that were in the locker will be sold at store/meeting. Prices to be decided, but bargain in any case.

There were 165 applications for the 2019 Metro Carvers show, Of those, 30 were received and we have 18 new as well for a total of 48 tables. This is down from last year and the trend seems to be less every year. Since the hall costs \$3100 and 48 tables really does not fill the hall. There are a couple of options that are being looked at. One is only renting half the hall, the other is to look for a smaller location. It was decided to hold off on flyers for next year as we are not sure, at this point, if there will be a show next year, and if so, will it be at the same location.

Another location that is fighting a smaller attendance, and will they be able to keep things going, is the Midland Seminar, sponsored by the Michigan Wood Carvers Association (MWCA). They have 54 total signed up and are looking to see if they will do the seminar next year. Most instructors do not have a full class and were told that only Gary Falin was fully booked, and some do not currently have anyone signed up. If you are planning on going, please signup. The instructors travel from distances, so it may not be worth their while to come for only 2 or 3 students.
